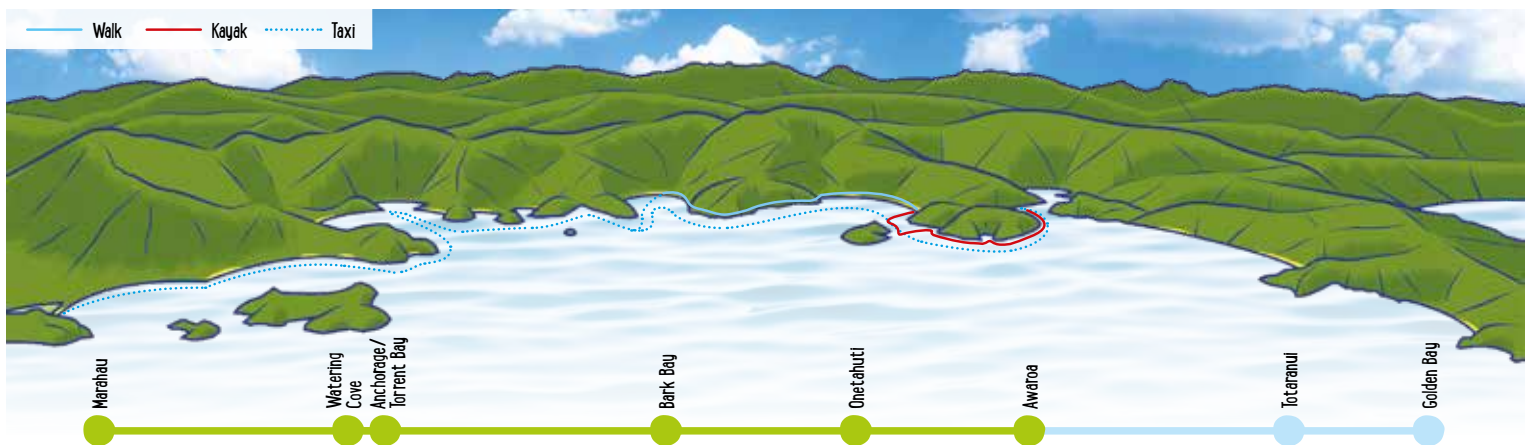

Kayak: Awaroa to Onetahuti.

Walk: Onetahuti to Bark Bay.

Description: Explore the realm of Tangaroa god of the sea, kayaking the northern reaches of the Tonga Island Marine Reserve. Spend the afternoon walking unguided from Onetahuti to Bark Bay. Feel the presence of Tāne Māhuta, god of the forest on this section of track. This is a trip you will remember for a long long time, as you live and breathe the soul of the Abel Tasman. We make getting there and back easy with a Water Taxi to start and finish the day.

ITINERARY*

- 8.15am** Check in and meet your guide.
- 8.30am** Water Taxi to Awaroa.
- 9.45am** Arrive Awaroa.
- 10.00am** Kayak from Awaroa to Onetahuti. Total kayak time approx 2 hours with breaks.
- 12.45pm** Enjoy lunch before setting off for your walk.
- 1.15pm** Walk from Onetahuti to Bark Bay. Approx 2 hours, 6.4km.
- 3.45pm** Water Taxi to Marahau.
- 4.30pm** Arrive back in Marahau.

What to bring:

Please bring personal water bottle, hat, sunscreen, insect repellent, towel, swimsuit, warm top (wool or fleece), wind jacket, a change of clothes, cameras and any medication.

We provide:

A top quality double sea kayak, lifejacket, paddle, spray skirt, paddle jacket, dry bags for cameras, a map and of course an awesome ATK guide.
